
Activities and Awareness Programs To educate and engage students and the community, several activities were conducted throughout the day:



- 3. Agro-Product Display Farmers exhibited their locally grown organic produce, including grains, fruits, and vegetables.




- 4. Workshops on Modern Farming Methods Experts provided guidance on crop diversification, water conservation, and improving soil fertility.
