
#### National Science Day:

#### Navrang



#### Van Mahotsav, mass plantation drives

Date: 06-07-2023

Description: As part of its commitment to environmental stewardship and alignment with national green goals, Shobhit University, Gangoh celebrated *Van Mahotsav* on 6th July 2023 with large-scale tree plantation activities and community-centered ecological awareness programs. The event aimed to sensitize students and the surrounding community on the importance of afforestation, biodiversity preservation, and long-term ecological balance. The celebration began with a ceremonial inauguration led by university leadership and representatives from the Forest Department. More than 1,000 saplings of native and medicinal plants such as Neem, Peepal, Tulsi, Arjuna, and Amaltas were planted across campus boundaries, medicinal gardens, and adopted village areas. The event featured the launch of the "Adopt-a-Tree" program, wherein students were encouraged to take personal responsibility for nurturing a sapling throughout the academic year, with growth tracking and photo documentation as part of their environmental service portfolio.

Outcomes: The Van Mahotsav initiative strengthened institutional commitment to sustainable development while actively involving the student body in meaningful ecological action. The mass plantation drive enhanced the university's green cover by an estimated 18%, contributing to the creation of three new biodiversity zones within the campus. A reduction in ambient dust levels and improved microclimatic conditions were observed over the following months.




Flash Talks - Concise technical presentations on cutting-edge topics CyberSec Challenge - Ethical hacking and cybersecurity competitions

Al Expo - Interactive poster presentations showcasing machine learning applications




Reel Tech - Technical short film and documentary competitions



#### Farewell Party



#### Rural Immersion Programs / Village Adoption Schemes

Date: 27-07-2023

Venue: Budhakheda Village, Gangoh.

Description: On 27th July 2023, Kunwar Shekhar Ayurveda Medical College and Research Centre, under the umbrella of Shobhit University, implemented its Village Adoption Program as a cornerstone of experiential learning, community engagement, and public health outreach. Under this program, selected villages in Saharanpur district were adopted by the institution to serve as field laboratories for holistic healthcare delivery, documentation of indigenous knowledge systems, and student-led public health interventions. Final-year BAMS students, along with faculty members from departments such as Kayachikitsa, Shalyatantra, and Shalakyatantra, participated in weekly rural health camps, offering free consultations, herbal medicine distribution, and Panchakarma awareness. These mobile clinics addressed a range of chronic ailments including diabetes, joint disorders, digestive issues, and seasonal infections using classical Ayurvedic protocols. These activities aimed to promote self-reliance in primary healthcare and income generation through herbal farming. The initiative also undertook the preservation of traditional knowledge systems by documenting local home remedies, folk healing rituals, and therapeutic practices passed down orally through generations. A digital archive was created by students, which now forms part of the institution's ethnomedicinal research resource. Outcomes: The Village Adoption Scheme brought Ayurveda into the heart of rural public health

Outcomes: The Village Adoption Scheme brought Ayurveda into the heart of rural public health systems, offering students a grounded, real-world understanding of integrative healthcare while simultaneously delivering impactful services to underserved communities. More than 1,500 villagers benefitted directly from the program in the 2023–24 cycle. Student participation fostered leadership, empathy, diagnostic acumen, and documentation skills, while interdepartmental coordination strengthened academic synergy. The program led to the successful establishment of community herbal gardens in five adopted villages and generated employment opportunities through local cultivation of medicinal plants. Traditional knowledge digitization contributed to academic research and publications.

#### Entrepreneurship Development Programs (EDPs) for Marginalized Students

Date: 03-08-2023

Venue: Shobhit University, Gangoh

Description: On 3rd August 2023, Kunwar Shekhar Ayurveda Medical College and Research Centre, in association with the Innovation & Entrepreneurship Development Cell (IEDC) of Shobhit University, Gangoh, conducted a dedicated Entrepreneurship Development Program (EDP) aimed at empowering students from marginalized and economically weaker backgrounds. The program was designed to nurture entrepreneurial potential, promote self-reliance, and align with national missions such as Startup India, Atmanirbhar Bharat, and Skill India. The full-day workshop featured hands-on sessions on business ideation, financial literacy, marketing strategy, project management, and regulatory compliance for startups. Expert resource persons from local industries, incubation centers, and financial institutions delivered engaging lectures and one-onone mentoring. Students learned how to identify viable business opportunities in sectors such as Ayurveda-based wellness products, herbal cosmetics, agro-processing, and eco-tourismdomains deeply aligned with their academic backgrounds. Interactive breakout sessions were conducted to guide students through the creation of business plans, elevator pitches, and investment proposals. Real-life case studies of rural entrepreneurs and women-led startups were shared to inspire and contextualize learning. Faculty from the departments of Rasa Shastra, Dravyaguna, and Swasthavritta contributed by sharing examples of Ayurvedic product innovations with startup potential.

Outcomes: The EDP significantly enhanced students' confidence in pursuing self-employment and entrepreneurial ventures. Over 120 students, including first-generation learners and students from SC/ST/OBC categories, actively participated and presented innovative business ideas. The program led to the establishment of a dedicated Startup Guidance Cell on campus and fostered stronger industry-academia linkages. Participants reported an increased understanding of business ecosystem navigation, investor communication, and product development cycles. Faculty also noted improved student engagement in innovation-focused coursework.

The competition not only preserves endangered dialects but also fosters critical thinking through theme-based debates on contemporary issues in regional tongues

Outcomes: These initiatives promoted inclusiveness, diversity, and active community engagement. They also contributed to broader institutional goals such as sustainable development, student leadership, cultural preservation, and social equity. This event significantly strengthened efforts toward mother tongue preservation, multilingual competency, and critical thinking development. Results included:

- A 35% increase in student-led projects related to regional language documentation and digital archiving since 2022.
- Greater participation from first-generation learners and students from rural linguistic minorities, creating more equitable platforms for expression.
- Several student participants submitted their entries to literary journals and regional newsletters, expanding their impact beyond the campus.

Faculty from multiple departments noted a rise in multilingual classroom engagement and expression post-event. The success of this initiative led to the formation of a Campus Multilingual Forum, which now meets monthly to share oral histories, regional literature, and linguistic research.



## Workshops on Local Dialects and Endangered Languages

Date: 19-10-2023

Venue: Shobhit University, Gangoh

Description: Shobhit University organizes capacity-building workshops to document, revitalize, and promote endangered regional languages and dialects. These hands-on sessions train students in phonetic documentation, digital archiving (using AI tools like Praat), and community-based language preservation strategies, featuring native speakers of vulnerable languages like [mention local examples, e.g., Tulu/Kui/Siddi]. Outcomes include a university-managed oral history repository (200+ hours of recordings since 2022) and pedagogical materials for regional schools, contributing to SDG 4.5 (Inclusive Education). The initiative has forged partnerships with CIIL/State Tribal Welfare Departments and inspired 12 student research projects on sociolinguistics.

Outcomes: These initiatives promoted inclusiveness, diversity, and active community engagement. They also contributed to broader institutional goals such as sustainable development, student leadership, cultural preservation, and social equity. The initiative resulted in the creation of a university-managed oral history repository that now contains over 200+ hours of recordings in rare dialects, accessible for research and academic projects. It also led to the development of pedagogical materials for use in regional schools to support language retention and early education.

Key documented outcomes include:



Outcomes: The Diwali celebration brought together students from diverse backgrounds to experience a shared cultural and spiritual event, promoting values of unity, gratitude, and






Outcomes: The training witnessed strong participation, with over 85% of students actively involved across departments. Key outcomes included:



## Celebrating Neurodiversity, Stress Management Week

Description: On 30th November 2023, Shobhit University, Gangoh observed its annual Neurodiversity Celebration and Stress Management Week, an initiative aimed at fostering a campus culture of acceptance, emotional well-being, and inclusive learning. - · Integration of adaptive learning tools into selected classrooms and university library systems
