








- I. **The efficacy of *Loha Churnadi Pralepa* in the management of *Vrana Vastu* w.r. to hypertrophic scar. – Dr. Naved Ahmed**
- a. The objective to be changed as below -
  - To understand the concept of hypertrophic scar.
  - To review and compile ayurvedic and modern literature of *Vrana vastu* & hypertrophic scar.
  - To review & make necessary attentions in the assessment of physical properties (of Hypertrophic scar).
  - Assessment period to be changed. Assessment to be done at day "0" (Before treatment) day "14" (after treatment 1) day "28" (after treatment 2).
- II. **Effect of *Kushmand Beej Tail Uttarabasti* in the management of *Matraghata* w.r. to BPH. – Dr. Mohit Bhati**
- Remove 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> point in Objective and add the term "efficacy and safety of drug" in 4<sup>th</sup> point.

- Inclusion criteria
  - The term 'mild BPH' to be changed to 'Grade 1 and Grade 2 BPH'.
  - In inclusive criteria, the lower limit of age of subjects to be changed from 45 to 35 years.
- Exclusion criteria
  - Subjects not having normal PSA value to be excluded from the study.
  - Subjects having other systemic diseases and bladder & ureteric calculi to be excluded from the study.
  - Subjects under medication to be excluded from the study.
- In Diagnostic criteria USG- KUB to be included.

III. **A clinical study on management of Primary Hydrocele ( *Matra Vridhhi* by *Vridhidhaman Lep* – Dr.Saif**

- Reframe Aims and Objectives.
- Assessment period to be changed. Assessment to be done at day "0" (Before treatment) day "14" (after treatment 1) day "28" (after treatment 2).

IV. **Development of Muro-adhesive gel from *Clerodendrum infortunatum* Linn.(*Bhandiraa*) root and leaf extract and its efficacy in *Saipo Prana*- in-vivo study – Dr.Shailesh Negi**

- Include Patch Test before application of Trial Drug.
- 4<sup>th</sup> Group should be removed.

V. **A clinical study to evaluate the effect of *BhaflatakadiModak* in *Arsha* w.r to Internal Haemorrhoids – Dr.Sagar Verma**

- Before the trial, the PG Scholar has to get Safety Certificate of Trial Drug from the manufacturer.

## ANNEXURE II

### DEPARTMENT OF KAYACHIKITSA - IEC SUGGESTIONS

I. A comparative clinical study to evaluate the efficacy of *Jirakadya Churna* and *Bhanisambadi Churna* in the management of *Grahani roga* w.s.r to Irritable bowel syndrome - Dr. Ajeet Maurya

- Pathya apathya if mentioned in the synopsis, then justification is needed whether it is action of drug or of Pathyapathya
- In exclusion criteria, include gastritis because the medicine contents can cause hyperacidity.
- Remove upper limit of age from age-group and write it as 'under 18 years will be excluded'
- In stool examination include the parasitic examination which affects the intestine.

II. A randomized comparative clinical trial to evaluate the efficacy of *Lashadi Churna* and *Kushta Bhasma* in the management of *Pandu* w.s.r to Iron deficiency anaemia - Dr. Anamika Yadav

- Instead of using the phrase "post screening" use the phrase "post study"
- Clarification of randomization to be given about 33 subjects in each group, by justifying the statistical formula
- Mention the range of LFT and KFT upto which subjects will be included due to mineral contents present in the medicine.
- To include TIDC and stool test in the investigation.
- Raktaasha and rakta pitta to be mentioned in Exclusion Criteria.
- In age restriction, remove upper limit.
- Vitamin C monitoring to be done because it helps iron absorption.



III. A randomized comparative clinical trial to evaluate the efficacy of *Charyadi Churna* with and without *Lekhana Basti* in the management of *Stoulya* (Obesity) - Dr. Parul

- In Exclusion Criteria mention the names of contra indication for Basti administration
- Specify the range of BP, DM, HBA1C in exclusion criteria
- In laboratory investigations, if possible reduce the no. of tests to reduce the study expenditure
- The upper limit of the age can be removed
- Note down/ check if the subject is allergic to contents of Basti.

IV. A comparative clinical study on the effect of *AdityapakwaGuduchiTaila* an *BhringarajaTaila* in the management of *Khalitya* w.s.r. to Alopecia - Dr. Sadhana

- Specify the time of application and duration (eg. Before or after bath) no. of times the oil to be applied once or twice a day, at night time, to use shampoo or not and if shampoo is used then mention the name.
- Exclude subjects taken/taking chemotherapy and steroid therapy
- Hair density to be checked in assessment criteria
- Consult a skin specialist for diagnosis of *Khalitya*
- Include patch test before application of trial drug

V. A comparative clinical study on the effect of *TilakusumadiLepa* and *SarjarasadiLepa* in the management of *Vipadika* (Palmo-Plantar Psoriasis) - Dr. Tushar

- In age restriction, remove upper limit
- Include patch test before application of trial drug
- Specify the time of application and duration of the trial drug (eg. once a day/twice a day)
- Clarification of randomization to be given about subjects in each group by justifying the statistical formula.

VI. A comparative Clinical study of *DraakshadiChurna* and *VasadiKwatha* in the management of *TamakaShwasa* w.r. to Bronchial asthma - Dr. Vikas

- Clarification of randomization to be given about subjects in each group by justifying the statistical formula.
- To include socio-economic group in the inclusion criteria
- Exclude the subjects who undergoes vigorous exercise
- To include spirometry in the investigation
